- Overlength: Applies to any one piece exceeding 8 feet (243.84 cm) in length and NOT exceeding 48 in (121.92cm) in width and height.
- Linear Foot rule: Applies to any shipment of multiple pieces that exceeds 144x96x96 inches (365.76x243.84x243.84 cm) in total.
- Shipments over 12 linear feet will need to be rated as a volume/full truck load by info@intlfreight.net.
